Michigan Child Protection Law Mandated Reporting Quick Reference Guide

Michigan child protection law <u>requires</u> mandated reporters who have reasonable cause to <u>suspect</u> child abuse or neglect to make an <u>immediate oral report</u> to MDHHS - Centralized Intake (855-444-3911), followed by a written report within 72 hours. Written reports may be made <u>online here</u>.

Three steps to fully comply with reporting requirements:

Make an immediate verbal report to (855)444-3911

Submit a written report to MDHHS within 72 hours

Notify your supervisor

- → Remember you are <u>NOT</u> the investigator. As mandated reporters it is our responsibility to report a suspicion of abuse or neglect to protective services at MDHHS. In turn, they will determine whether to proceed with an investigation.
- → Mandated reporters must notify their supervisor of the report. Remember reporting the suspected allegations of child abuse and/or neglect to your supervisor does NOT fulfill the requirement to report directly to MDHHS.
