Reconfirmation Meeting for November 12, 2020

Reconfirm how instruction (Return to Learn Plan) is going to be delivered during the 20/21 school year:

(Recommendation: Explain in narrative form any modifications to the original Extended Learning Plan)

In response to the PHDM recommendation on November 4, 2020, MCISD will change instruction for the following programs/classrooms:

- Severe Cognitive Impairment Classroom (SCI): Starting Monday November 6th, this classroom will move to 100% Virtual Instruction.
- Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP): The goal of our GSRP classrooms will be to get class sizes under 10. This guidance comes from Guidelines for Safe Child Care Operations During COVID-19 developed by LARA. GSRP classrooms must maintain an approved day care license, which applies a different and often more stringent standard to meet than the typical school classroom. In both the SAPS and MAPS classroom we will move into a hybrid model where half students are face to face and half the students are learning virtually. The students will be in two different groups with each group alternating face to face instruction every two days. This will allow each classroom size to be under 10 students. (We will not have to do this at NCA as their classroom is already under 10.) We will start this format the week of November 16 and it will continue until Winter break (Dec 21).
- Moderately Cognitive Impaired Classroom (MOCI): Our MOCI students share services and classes
 with Menominee Junior/Senior High School. We will be working with Menominee in the near future as
 they craft their response. Most likely any changes that will occur will start the week of November 16th
 and continue at least until December 21st. Menominee Junior/Senior High School (and the ISD MOCI
 class) will move to 100% virtual instruction until November 30th.
